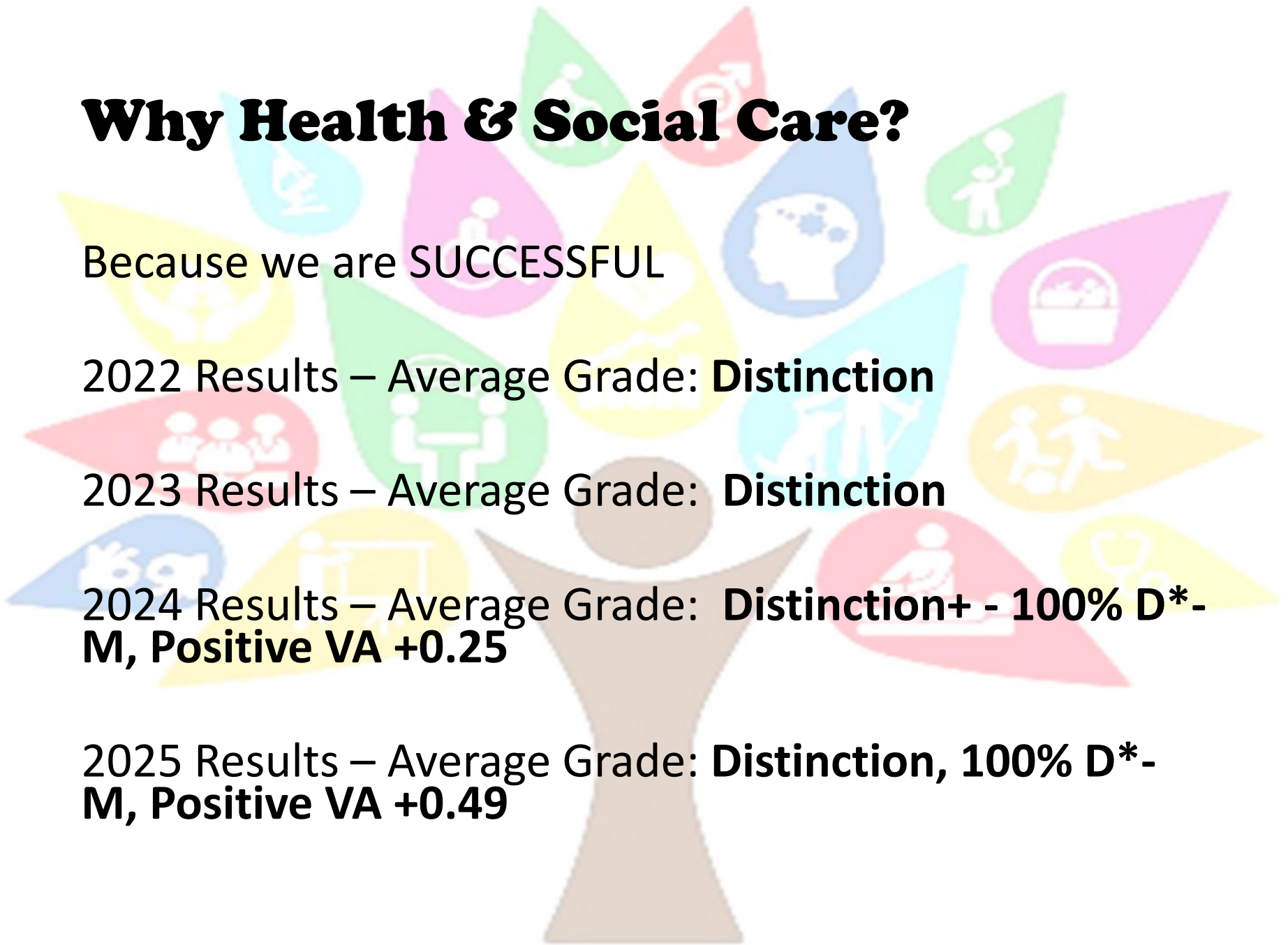

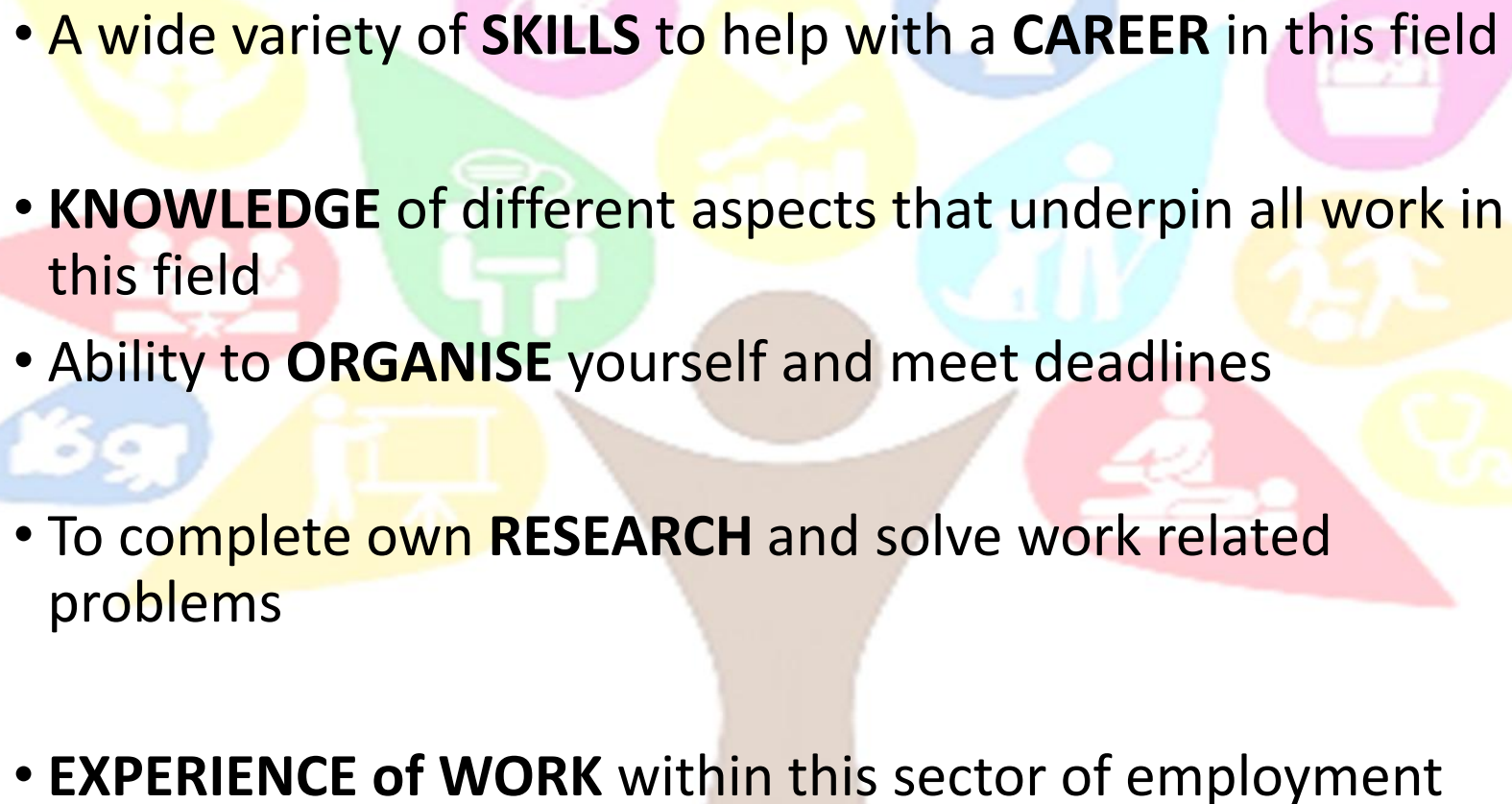

What can you gain from Health & Social Care?

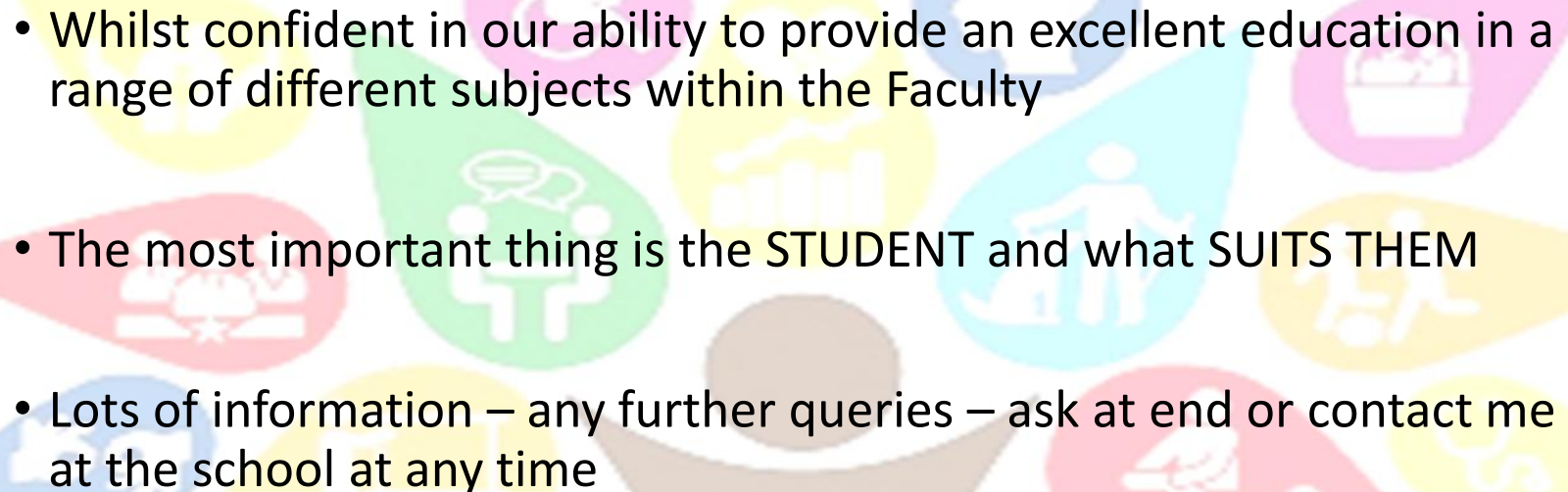
- A wide variety of **SKILLS** to help with a **CAREER** in this field
